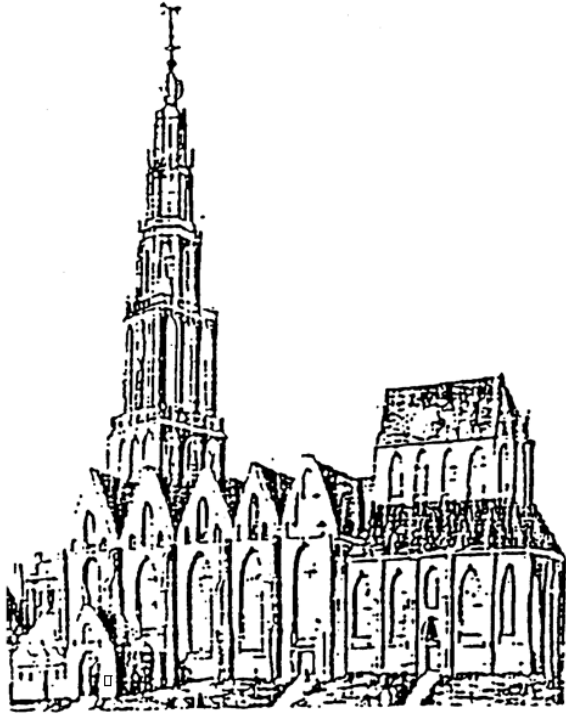

### WORDS OF WELCOME

Officiant: We have come together in the name of Christ to offer  
 our praise and thanksgiving, to hear and receive God's  
 holy word, to pray for the needs of the world, and to seek

the forgiveness of our sins, that by the power of the Holy Spirit we may give ourselves to the service of God. Christ calls us to share the heavenly banquet of his love with all the saints in earth and heaven. Knowing our unworthiness and sin, let us ask from him both mercy and forgiveness.

### Incantation - Czeslaw Milosz

Human reason is beautiful and invincible.

     and his truth endureth from generation to generation.

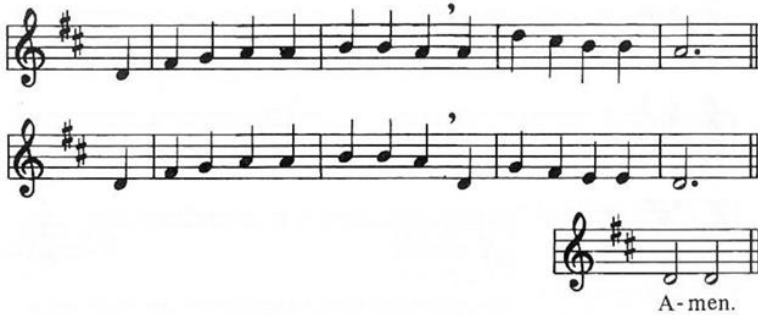
